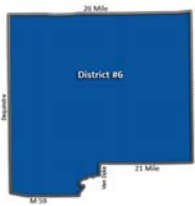
## Veterans Food Bank is Here to Help

Commissioner James Carabelli was elected November 2010 to his second two-year term as a county commissioner. He represents the residents of Shelby Township in District 6.



Carabelli is serving his second term as co-chair of the Planning & Economic Development Committee, and has served as vice-chair of the Buildings, Roads & Public Works Committee, and as a member of the Courts & Legal Affairs, Finance, Personnel and Public Services committees.

Before joining the County Board, Carabelli was elected to two four-year terms as a member of the Shelby Township Board of Trustees, serving from 2000 to 2008. He is also a former chairman of the Macomb County Republican Party; a post he held from 2004-08.
