Dear Commissioner Crouchman:

By this letter I am informing the County that I have appointed the Deputy Court Administrator, Ms. Sandy Kegler, as Court Administrator for the 42-1 District Court pursuant to M.C.L. 600.8281 effective immediately.

Ms. Kegler has served this Court and the County for sixteen years, the last 11½ of which have been in Court Administration. Therefore, because of her long service and high qualifications I have appointed her and am requesting that she be paid at \$63,318.09 annually as was her predecessor, Ms. Diane Smiles, who retired from her long and excellent service to the County on 1/29/10.


In view of these very difficult economic times and the long discussed and urgent need for additional security here at the Court, I would make the following proposal to the County Board:

As Deputy Court Administrator Ms. Kegler was paid \$49,194.76 annually. Although I could do so under M.C.L. 600.8281, I am willing to not appoint to the Deputy Court Administrator position, that position would be abolished and those funds used to solve the longstanding security issues here at the Court. I propose the creation of a new Senior Administration Clerk position (with the present salary range of \$32,841.75 – 38,637.36). This Senior Clerk will specifically be assigned, along with other appropriate duties, to support the Court Administrator. I would intend to promote one of the existing Deputy Court Clerk II employees (salary range of \$29,792.38 – 35,049.86) to that position, about a \$3,500.00 difference.

For all the reasons I have extensively discussed with the Commission previously, part of these savings would be reinvested in this Court by having an additional Court Officer/Bailiff (salary range of \$28,596.75 – 33,643.24). This would result in net savings to the County of approximately \$15,000.00 and solve our outstanding safety issues.

Would you please place this proposal on your next available agenda as I consider this imperative for the smooth administration and security of the Court.

RESOLUTION REQUESTING STATE ASSISTANCE IN THE FUNDING OF 42<sup>ND</sup>  
DISTRICT COURTS, DIVISION I AND II

Distributed

**WHEREAS**, the County of Macomb has within its borders district courts which include the 37<sup>th</sup>, 38<sup>th</sup>, 39<sup>th</sup>, 40<sup>th</sup>, 41-A, 41-B and the 42<sup>nd</sup> District Court, Division I and II, and

**WHEREAS**, all of the district courts, except the 42<sup>nd</sup> District Court, Division I and II are district courts of the third class and whose district funding unit(s) or district control unit(s) are the cities or townships in which the district court has jurisdiction. The 42<sup>nd</sup> District Court, Division I, which consists of the Cities of Memphis and Richmond, the Townships of Bruce, Washington, Armada, Ray and Richmond and the 42<sup>nd</sup> District Court, Division II, which consists of the City of New Baltimore and the Townships of Lennox and Chesterfield are, pursuant to MCL 600.8122(7), districts of the second class, and

**WHEREAS**, district courts of the first or second class, including the 42<sup>nd</sup> District Court, Division I and II have the local county as their district funding unit or district control unit, and

**WHEREAS**, a district funding unit, by state statute, is responsible for maintaining, financing and operating the court, and

**WHEREAS**, the total responsibility for funding the 42<sup>nd</sup> District Court, Division I and II falls upon all tax payers of the County of Macomb, the majority of which are already supporting, through their tax dollars paid to their local municipality, district courts where they live, and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Macomb for the year 2010 has budgeted \$1,071,278 to support Division I of the 42<sup>nd</sup> District Court and \$1,333,290 to fund the activities of Division II of the 42<sup>nd</sup> District Court, and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Macomb has no option but to support the 42<sup>nd</sup> District Court, Division I and II because of the state statutes making them second class district courts and further, requiring revenues generated from those courts to be shared with the state and local municipalities, resulting in what is the equivalent of an unfunded mandate, and

**WHEREAS**, the funding of the 42<sup>nd</sup> District Court, Division I and II is a double taxation burden upon the majority of the taxpayers in Macomb County because of their support of district courts in areas where they reside and pay taxes.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Macomb County Board of Commissioners hereby implores the state legislature to adopt legislation to either: (1) Allow the County of Macomb in its support of the 42<sup>nd</sup> District Court, Division I and II to retain all or most of the monies generated from fines and fees before any such money is remitted to the state. (2) Amend the state statute to require the state to pay for any monetary deficit incurred with the County in the running of those courts.

**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING LEGISLATION TO REQUIRE  
THE STATE TO FUND ALL STATE COURTS**

**WHEREAS**, the circuit, probate and district courts throughout the state are funded largely by monies from the general funds of various local units of government, and

**WHEREAS**, in most counties the responsibility for funding the circuit and probate courts falls upon the counties having a circuit and probate court located within its geographical boundaries as well as the responsibility for funding some, if not all, district courts located in the county, and

**WHEREAS**, various cities, townships and villages along with counties have the responsibility for funding district courts located within their jurisdictional boundaries, and

**WHEREAS**, the responsibility for funding said courts law by the counties, cities, townships and villages throughout the State of Michigan are required by state statute, and

**WHEREAS**, the responsibility for the funding of said courts should be that of the State and not the local units of government, and

**WHEREAS**, monies generated from courts through fines and costs should the State take over their funding would become the property of the State to offset the costs of operating the courts.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Macomb County Board of Commissioners hereby implores the state legislature to adopt legislation to amend current laws requiring the funding of circuit, probate and district courts to be the responsibility of the local units of government and to pass legislation that will require the State to fund the circuit, probate and district courts throughout the State of Michigan.
