At a **joint** meeting of the **Justice & Public Safety and Health & Human Services Committees**, held Wednesday, April 13, 2016, in the Board Room, on the 9th Floor of the Administration Building, Mount Clemens, the following members were present:

There being a quorum of the committee present, JPS Chair Vosburg called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

AGENDA

MOTION

A motion was made by Carabelli, supported by Tocco, to adopt the agenda, as presented. **The Motion Carried.**

AGREEMENT WITH CORRECT CARE SOLUTIONS/INMATE HEALTHCARE SERVICES MANAGEMENT/SHERIFF

Sheriff Wickersham acknowledged the upcoming retirement of Jail Administrator Michelle Sanborn after 32 years and thanked her for all of her hard work.

Sheriff Wickersham and Ms. Sanborn spoke about their recommendation to continue the agreement with Correct Care Solutions to provide inmate healthcare services.

MOTION

A motion was made by Sauger, supported by Mijac, to forward to the Finance Committee a recommendation to approve the Correct Care Solutions contract to continue healthcare services to prisoners with the incumbent vendor.

Chair Vosburg called for a vote on the motion and <u>The Motion Carried</u> with Marino voting "No."

BUDGET AMENDMENT/MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT EXPENSES/ FRIEND OF THE COURT

MOTION

A motion was made by Tocco, supported by Duzyj, to forward to the Finance Committee a recommendation to approve an amendment to the Friend of the Court's 2016 budget to include an additional \$131,809.22; the additional revenue was a result of monies received from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Third Party Liability Division; further, this budget action addresses budgetary issues only. It does not constitute the Commission's approval of any County contract. If a contract requires Commission approval under the County's Contracting Policy or the County's Procurement Ordinance, such approval must be sought separately.

Tom Blohm, Friend of the Court Director, gave an overview of the amendment, noting it is a 15 percent reimbursement.

Chair Vosburg called for a vote on the motion and **The Motion Carried**.

Health and Human Services Committee Chair Duzyj chaired the meeting.
